Sing a song

Take turns to choose a song to sing to pass the time. Can you change the words to match the situation? *E.g. Old MacDonald had a park; This is the way we mow the lawn...*



Keep the Beat

Choose an action to do (E.g. stamping, jumping, shaking keys, waving). Clap/tap a beat for your child to do the action in time to. Take turns to change the action.

Can you see a...

Keep your child busy with things to look for. Try making it into a competition. *E.g. first one to see a car, pushchair, dog, traffic lights, hat, tractor.*



Yes versus no!

Choose a category / opposites and use these to describe things you see. *E.g. healthy/not healthy; grows/doesn't grow; bigger than me/not bigger*
